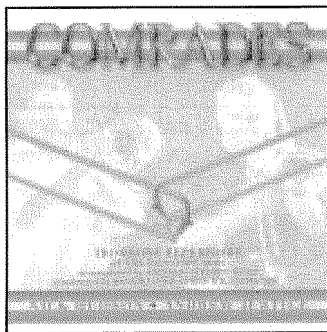


Hudson and Justice team up to great effect

THIS release on the SPS label features two of the band world's finest exponents of the trombone, Nick Hudson and Andrew Justice, accompanied by the Enfield Citadel Band under James Williams MBE.

Thirteen tracks of quality music include solos and duets in pieces such as the title track, Comrades by Albert Jakeway, Dudley Bright's When Jesus, Divine Gratitude from the highly respected Ivor Bosanko, Bruce Broughton's My Refuge, A Never Failing Friend by that master of the solo, Erik Leidzen, and Ralph Pearce's Rhapsody on An American Folk Hymn.

A superb Stephen Bulla creation, Peace Like a River, provides the finale to this

highly enjoyable disc and finds both soloists joining with the trombone section of Enfield Citadel.

As one would expect, both trombonists are in great form and compliment each other so well.

The music is varied and of a high quality – something one can almost take for granted with the inclusion of those already mentioned alongside others such as Ray Steadman-Allen, Terry Camsey, William Himes, Don Morrison and Norman Bearcroft.

The band, under the expert direction of James Williams, provides the perfect platform for these two superb trombonists.
